Go to https://uanet.org for information on your certifications and online UA course offerings such as an AWS-CWI Prep Course, Auto CAD, Labor History and service related courses (Electrical Controls/Refrigeration Controls/HVACR Star Exam) among others.

Please see below for some other highlights this semester:

o Course Sign Up -

- YOU MUST SIGN UP TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO THE START OF CLASS (We need to have time to have materials available for you at the start of class.) Sign up at www.ualocal434.org.
- Classes will be cancelled one week prior to the start of class if not enough members are signed up.
- o Expect all classes to utilize Blackboard in some way.

Welding Classes/Manuals

- Pre-requisite All apprentices must complete Local 434 Oxy-Fuel and Shop Safety. All members are encouraged to take this class.
- You will be keeping track of your own welding progression in the manual you receive at your 1st welding class.
- O You will not be placed on a roster until you have completed the Local 434 Torch and Welding Safety Class **and** sent in your deposit check. You must complete this class at least one week prior to the welding class start date.
 - Make check payable to: UA Local 434 Training and mail to the Eau Claire Training Center.
- o If you need to drop a welding class that you have signed up for, you must go to the website to cancel your registration at least one week in advance in order to get your deposit check back. If you don't, your deposit check will be cashed.
- o In order to take a UA Weld Test, an ATR will need to approve you.

Flame Safeguard Training

- Steve Young from SY Training will teach a class covering CSD-1 Overview, Flame Detection Systems, 7800Series Controls, 7800 Series Fault codes, and he will be using a 7800 Series tester to go thru the Keyboard display to show how it works as a service tool.
- This one day class will be held on Thursday, October 19th, 2017 from 4:30pm to 8:30pm in all locations.

o NCCCO Crane Signaling Certification and Re-Certification

- O You must sign up 4 weeks in advance. Tests need to be applied for from NCCCO.
- o If your certification will be expiring in the next year, you will need to retake the practical exam to re-new your certification.
- o If you expire in the spring of 2018 you can take the class/test now, and your certification month and day won't change. (Only the year will be updated.)

o NITC Medical Gas Re-Certification

- o Med Gas Re-Certification classes will be held at all Training Centers this semester. Must be signed up three weeks before test.
- Anyone needing to re-certify only needs to take the written open book exam.

Course Overlaps

 Many classes run on the same nights, before you enroll please check the dates of classes to be sure they don't run on the same nights.

o Training Center Use

- o All members (including instructors) using shop must call me when arriving at and leaving the shop.
- Also call a couple days prior to using the shop to ensure that you have the correct code.
- O You must sign in; please list any broken tools or untidiness that you find and clean the shop.
- Anyone not following procedures will lose privileges to use the training center.
- o Instructors Needed (we would like 2 instructors for each class in each area, so that substitute teachers are available.)
 - HVAC Instructors needed in All Locations
 - o OSHA Instructor needed in La Crosse
 - o Plumbing Instructor needed in La Crosse
 - O Please contact me if you are able to help with any classes in any location
